Although the pandemic forced everyone into a lockdown, events at Mira's thrived virtually with immense fervour from both faculty as well as students. Many cultural events were hosted by various departments and were open to participation from the entire college and while Sports activities could not take place outdoors, the Department of Physical Education organized two daily batches of online physical fitness sessions along with webinars and virtual sports events and competitions. International Yoga Day and National Sports Day celebrations are annually conducted. The Cultural Committee hosts a plethora of events through the year which allow participants to sing, dance, draw, write, recite, act and perform stand-up comedy. The college also hosts cultural celebrations such as Gurunanak Jayanti, Janmashtami, Ganesh Utsav, Guru Nanak Jayanti, Navratri, Christmas Celebrations, Hindi Diwas and Marathi Diwas. In addition, several days of national and international significance are observed like the International Peace Day, Electoral Day, Constitution Day, National Youth Day, Nagasaki Day and Teachers' Day. **CULTURAL EVENTS 2017-2018**

The academic year 2017-18 was, as always, an eventful one. Allow us to take you on a quick round up of the College Cultural Activities for this year:

**Eco-friendly Ganpati Idol-making Activity**

Last year, the students of the Green Club were inspired after viewing a video on You Tube and after learning the nuances from a professional artist. This year, the students handled the making of the idol themselves, with a little input from the teachers.

This year, we prepared the idol on 24<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2017 using wet paper and 'shaadumatti' (river bed clay) mixed with some organic resin. Care was taken to use lentil seeds and sago for decoration of Lord Ganesha's headgear. The students also prepared a small mouse-*Bappa*'s charioteer- out of waste material.

Our '*Green Bappa*' was installed on 25th August-the first day of '*GaneshaSthapana*' in the Sanctuary- a place where all Miraites (Degree College and Junior College) spend some time every morning, imbibing good values, good thoughts and in meditation. The idol was installed for a period of 5 days during which students handled the '*pooja*', '*aarti*' and '*prasad*' distribution to all. This year, our Ganeshotsav festivities received live coverage from 95Big FM. We had MJ Sangram in our midst much to the joy of the students.

On the day of the '*Visarjan*', the sound of drum beats and cries of '*Ganpati Bappa*' and '*Pudchiya Varshi Laukar ya*' resonated on the campus. With this, our '*Green Bappa*' was surrendered to his watery abode.

Instead of conducting the immersion at the river side, we immersed our '*Bappa*' in a bucket of clean water as was done earlier. Last year, the dissolved clay found its way back into the plants on our campus. This year, more soil was added in the clay and water solution and seeds were sown in the same. The idea was to use the saplings emerging from the germinated seeds for greening our campus.

**Green Club Sale**

Sanctuary about the benefits of Re-use and Recycling. The theme of this exercise was "Old is Gold".

At the Mira Bazaar, the Green Club put up two stalls-one dedicated for a **Jumble Sale of pre-owned apparel** (ethnic and western womenswear and menswear) and the other focussing on sale of **pre-owned costume jewellery, greeting cards and candles (made out of recycled material) and the vermi-compost manure** harvested on campus. All items were nominally priced between Rs.10/- to Rs.50/- each. The vermi-compost packets were available for Rs.10/- each. The Sale generated a revenue of Rs 4481/- from pre-owned apparel, Rs1675/-from restored jewellery and remade candles and Rs1200/- from manure, harvested on-campus from the Garden Waste Management Project.

The academic year 2017-18 was, as always, an eventful one. Allow us to take you on a quick round up of the College Cultural Activities for this year:

**Eco-friendly Ganpati Idol-making Activity**

Last year, the students of the Green Club were inspired after viewing a video on You Tube and after learning the nuances from a professional artist. This year, the students handled the making of the idol themselves, with a little input from the teachers.

This year, we prepared the idol on 24<sup>th</sup> Aug, 2017 using wet paper and 'shaadumatti' (river bed clay) mixed with some organic resin. 
Our '*Green Bappa*' was installed on 25th August-the first day of '*GaneshaSthapana*' in the Sanctuary- a place where all Miraites (Degree College and Junior College) spend some time every morning, imbibing good values, good thoughts and in meditation. The idol was installed for a period of 5 days during which students handled the '*pooja*', '*aarti*' and '*prasad*' distribution to all. This year, our Ganeshotsav festivities received live coverage from 95Big FM. We had MJ Sangram in our midst much to the joy of the students.

On the day of the '*Visarjan*', the sound of drum beats and cries of '*Ganpati Bappa*' and '*Pudchiya Varshi Laukar ya*' resonated on the campus. With this, our '*Green Bappa*' was surrendered to his watery abode.

Instead of conducting the immersion at the river side, we immersed our '*Bappa*' in a bucket of clean water as was done earlier. Last year, the dissolved clay found its way back into the plants on our campus. This year, more soil was added in the clay and water solution and seeds were sown in the same. The idea was to use the saplings emerging from the germinated seeds for greening our campus.

**Green Club Sale**

This year the Green Club declared its intention to mobilise resources for College Garden maintenance. It was decided that the Mira Bazaar would be a suitable platform for doing so, since it attracts many footfalls. This exercise commenced with a pre-sale orientation during

Sanctuary about the benefits of Re-use and Recycling. The theme of this exercise was “Old is Gold”.

At the Mira Bazaar, the Green Club put up two stalls-one dedicated for a **Jumble Sale of pre-owned apparel** (ethnic and western womenswear and menswear) and the other focussing on sale of **pre-owned costume jewellery, greeting cards and candles (made out of recycled material)** and the vermi-compost manure harvested on campus. All items were nominally priced between Rs.10/- to Rs.50/- each. The vermi-compost packets were available for Rs.10/- each. The Sale generated a revenue of Rs 4481/- from pre-owned apparel, Rs1675/-from restored jewellery and remade candles and Rs1200/- from manure, harvested on-campus from the Garden Waste Management Project.

##### **Activities under the banner of CWE:**


- **Mira Bazaar**





#### • Sadhu Vaswani Inter College Debate



- **International Day of Peace:**




