Inaugural Programme 2018-19 --- 6th August 2018

The Inaugural function for 2017-18 was held on 6th August 2018 Mr. Anwar Rajan (Maharashtra Gandhi Smarak Nidhi, Pune) , inaugurated the yearly activities of the department. He is a well known social activist who has worked in the field of religious unity and has participated in promoting the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi.



He oriented the SS volunteers on the topic, 'Youth and Social Service'. He spoke about 'cleaning of the minds before cleaning of the society' and gave an alternative perspective of social service. He also discussed about the chronic problems in Indian society like superstitions, casteism, religious hatred, forms of inequalities, untouchability, and gender discrimination. He urged the volunteers to try and

change the mindset of the society, but first initiating a change in our attitudes, perceptions and outlook towards various facets of the society. Sir emphasized on modern values like democracy, secularism, equality and fraternity. He also explained the relevance of the Gandhian thoughts with respect to

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




KAR SEVA- AT SADHU VASWANI MISSION

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Report- Tree Plantation- 4th July 2017

The NSS Department, St. Mira's College for Girls organised the Tree Plantation Drive on 4th July 2017. The tree plantation was conducted in association with the Botanical Survey of India, Koregaon Park Pune at their Mundwa Campus. 30 Trees were planted by the students which included- Bottle Palm, Mahogany, Phonex and Jamun Trees.

The programme was organised by Prof. Veena Kenchi (NSS PO) and Dr. Meenal Sumant (NSS PO).

Dr. Jadhav, Dr. Jalal of the Botanical Survey of India guided the student volunteers in planting the trees. There will be regular monitoring and recording of the growth of these trees planted.

NSS Department of St. Mira's college celebrated 1st to 15th August as Swachhata Pakhwada.



The focus was on orientation and sensitization of students regarding responsible behaviour in garbage disposal and general habits of cleanliness. For this- poster- making, talks and documentary screening was done. Last year, the NSS volunteers were given a task of identifying a swacchata related problem in the college campus. As our continuing efforts for responsible disposal of used sanitary pads, the NSS department took a two way initiative of

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orienting students about responsible ways of disposing of sanitary pads and facilitating it by providing paper bags made out of old newspapers and magazines. NSS volunteers took up the responsibility of orienting and encouraging their classmates in this endeavor throughout the year. The NSS volunteers made the paper bags to be used for this project.

Following programmes were organized by the Dept to create awareness, analyse and sensitize the students about the problem of cleanliness.





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NSS DAY - 24TH SEPTEMBER 2018



1. Awareness Campaign-

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


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
SURGICAL STRIKE DAY - 29th September 2018

The National Unity Day 2018 was celebrated the Department of NSS, Student Development Cell and the Library of St. Mira's College for girls, Pune.


On this occasion, following activities were undertaken-

The families of the Sevaks and Sevikas enjoyed various stalls of Mehendi, Tattoo and games arranged by the volunteers



Electoral Day Celebration- 25th January 2019, Friday



The discussion included Prime Minister Modi discussing stress management, time management which will help students to develop and take decisions for their future.










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Two Day State Level NSS Seminar 23rd and 24th February, 2019.

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VALEDICTORY FUNCTION




The programme started with invoking the blessings of the almighty by lighting of the lamp, followed by the university song and NSS song.

In pre-dinner session the volunteers of both the colleges were engaged in an interactive session of getting to know the fellow volunteers and their motivation for joining NSS.


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

Day 6 – 14/12/2018; Friday


Our mornings in the camp started with prayer i.e. Sanctuary, followed by University Song, NSS Song and exercises.

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


Day 7 – 15/12/2018, Saturday






