On 21st July 2022, the Green Club of St. Mira's College for Girls organized a session titled, "Solid Waste Management". The session was a joint initiative by Green Club and Janwani (a public charitable trust formed by Maratha Chamber of Commerce, Industries and Agriculture, Pune) and Adar Poonawalla Clean City Initiative. 124 students of Second Year across different streams attended the program with Green Club faculties.

Mr. Shaikh Faiz Ahmed (Janwani and Adar Poonawalla Clean City Initiative) spoke about causes of piling up of solid wastes and the ways to alleviate it. The speaker introduced the audience to the rationale of APCCI. According to APCCI the waste and garbage not only is damaging our health and environment but it is an embarrassment to foreigners and visitors who visit India. Today it has over 200 trucks/ machines and over 400 employees for managing this activity covering more than 600 kms of roads in Pune.

The clean city initiative addresses this issue by deploying state of the art machines. Equipment deployed include, Glutton Vacuum Litter Picker, Trilo Vacuum Truck, Truck Mounted Road Sweepers, which uses the best technology to pick up and clear the waste from the streets. Vehicle mounted pothole filling machine to fill potholes in the shortest possible time.

The speaker discussed the way all individuals can work towards cutting down waste creation and adopt recycling.


Mr. Ahmed along with his team on behalf of APCCI appealed to the staff and faculties to contribute by participating in the various initiatives of the organisation.

Workshop on – “CCI Sustainability (Corporate, Community, Individual): Waste Segregation and Disposal”

Law Club Initiative

The Law Club of the Department of Accountancy organized a Workshop on the topic “CCI Sustainability (Corporate, Community, Individual): Waste Segregation and Disposal” for second year Commerce students on 16th March 2022 from 12:15pm to 01:45pm. The workshop was conducted by Mr. Sathya Natarajan, a Red Dot Campaigner, an Environment Foot Soldier and a National Coordinator, Urban Spaces - Climate Reality Project, India.

The session commenced with a rationale of the Workshop followed by an introduction of the speaker and his various initiatives to protect the environment. The speaker, with the help of a quiz introduced the participants to various types of Wastes generated and its segregation at the source. This was followed by statistics about the gigantic waste generated and the challenging task of its disposal and management faced by the civic authorities and its impact on the environment. The significance of the new decentralized Waste Management paradigm and its positive impact on the planet were also focused upon.

The Workshop basically highlighted the significance of the Red Dot Campaign in the light of the threat caused by the lack of awareness about the ways to dispose sanitary waste (a hazardous type of a waste) impacting the health of the waste collectors thereby emphasizing on the dignity of labour. The speaker also underlined the significance of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and certain laws in the context of waste segregation and disposal.

The session concluded with a vote of thanks to the speaker.




"A better environmental future requires better environmental awareness for future generations." The United Nations (UN) celebrates


10. Panel Discussion on Eliminating Use of Plastic – 25th June 2021 -

Green Club and NSS Department held a Panel

Discussion on 25th June 2021 between 10am to 11.15 am on Google meet. The dialogue began with introducing the topic- Miss Shannon R talked about what goes around comes around. Ocean throws garbage (created by us) back to us, so it is our collective responsibility to reduce garbage as much as possible. Miss Rakhi pointed out that it takes about 4000 years for plastic to degrade, hence we should say “No” to use of polythene bags. Miss Namrata Datta added to this discussion regarding reusable H2O bottle plus cloth bags- At present, plastic use is choking us and We are the change makers, need determination to bring the change. Miss Maitrayee Sangittrao highlighted how everywhere plastics are used right from makeup/spectacles. She concluded by asking audience these questions- Do we need it, is it necessary?? We must decide how much plastic to be used in everyday life.

Miss Gauri Raje stated that change begins at home - we must adopt zero plastic-based lifestyle, however challenging it is. She gave examples of using bamboo brush, upcycling old clothes, not to cut plastic pouches completely to avoid microplastics, encouraged to use menstrual cups. Miss Saloni Kullar spoke about human beings at our best are extremely creative, she added to switch to ink pens, cut gel pens can be used as beads, plastic stand of pens stuck together etc. Miss Annmariya said that plastic creates scarcity of land , alternative is use metal straw. Miss Kajal Yadav coaxed all to buy bigger bottles to avoid using more of plastic consumption. Miss Riya Pawar spoke about how plastic tiffin boxes can be reused as jewellery boxes, use cloth flowers, use paper cups, etc. Miss Anushka said that living a simple life is not easy but everyone can do it. Miss Aariya Parve shared here ideas of the various means to cut down plastic such as use of paper glasses, wire hangers etc.

Audience participation showed an overwhelming response to this discussion. Miss Kanishka informed to use steel items for milk cans. Miss Nivedita Sahoo suggested use of wooden items in the kitchen. Miss Shannon encouraged audience to use cotton based sanitary towels, use metals instead of paper because trees are being harmed, use paper bags which are made out of newspapers. Miss Rajni Singh, Inhouse faculty said that be responsible consumers , make producers to rethink






the use of plastic material for packaging and at the end Miss Gauri discussed the taboo relating to Menstrual cups.



Skill Development of Effective Waste-Management Practices in Environment

The SPPU Research Foundation and the Australian Institute of Water Sciences jointly organized a Webinar on 18th Jan, 2021. The Webinar was conducted between 3:00pm to 4:00pm.

The Opening address were made by Dr Nitin Karmalkar, V.C. SPPU and himself an expert in Environmental Science. This was followed by observations made by Dr Shaligram, former COE and CEO SPPU Research Park Foundation. Finally, Prof Phil Bell of the Australian Institute of Water Sciences spoke about skill development and environmental opportunities in the field of waste water treatment, solid waste management, e-waste management, bio-medical waste management, air pollution management.

Prof. Bell opined that these opportunities exist and can be tapped via Environmental Education – through introduction of introductory, Intermediate and Advanced courses offered by the Australian Institute of Social Sciences.

The Australian institute wishes to promote 2-4 research-oriented courses per year in collaboration with SPPU, with a maximum strength of 50 students per course. The curriculum would be designed by the Australian counterpart while the infrastructure would be made available at SPPU or SPPU affiliated college end. This webinar aimed at skill development in the field of environmental science with focus on waste management.


The main takeaways of the webinar were that inter-university student exchange would receive an impetus, there would be scope for technology transfer, skill training from globally recognized experts and advisory services for waste management. This SPPU driven activity is a good endeavour for raising green consciousness of students who wish to be global citizens, green skill building, green ideation, with potential for obtaining green internships.

e) Display of Books on Swami Vivekananda by the Library




The programme was organised by Prof. Veena Kenchi (NSS PO) and Dr. Meenal Suman (NSS PO).




Report of the Event: Greeting Card Making and Candle Making



Report of the Event: Green Club Jumble Sale – 16th Dec 2017


Report of the Event: Garden Waste Management – Harvesting of Manure 14-15th Dec 2017



2. Tree Plantation-

Following programmes were organised by the Dept to create awareness, analyse and sensitize the students about the problem of cleanliness.



Preamble

The Stockholm Conference on the Human Environment, 1972, drew attention to the need for green education i.e. education relating to environment protection. The most oft quoted definition of Sustainable development has been given by the United Nations World Commission on Environment and Development (Brundtland Commission) in its 1987 Report, 'Our Common Future' which defines it as development "which meets the needs of the present without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs."

Mankind has pursued increased industrialisation and urbanisation and brought about economic development, which has often been at the cost of tremendous environmental degradation. We have been witnessing this in the form of pollution, acid rain, deforestation, desertification, ozone-depletion, global warming, early signs of climate change.


In 2008, the G8 University Summit adopted the Sapporo Sustainability Declaration for internalising environmental consciousness in university academic frameworks and on campus. In 2015, India committed itself to the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development (for fulfilment of the UN Sustainable Development Goals 2015-2030). The UGC has laid down the SATAT framework to encourage environment friendly practices on campuses of Higher Educational Institutions. In keeping with the UGC's guidelines, St. Mira's College for Girls, Pune has adopted an Environment Sustainability Policy.
